



The region is a melting pot of cultures and communities and represents one of the greatest genetic variances on the continent. Many describe the Omo as the cradle where it all began.

Day 1: Your arrival in Addis Ababa

You will be met at **Bola International Airport** by your professional guide and driver, then driven directly to your booked hotel in **Addis Ababa**. After checking in at the hotel, you will meet your driver and guide. Your first destination will be the **National Museum**, where you can see the oldest fossil of Lucy, then you will have a lunch break. Visit the Entoto Mariam Monastery and the Palace of Menelik II, to learn more about the emperor who founded Addis Ababa as the capital of Ethiopia. During lunch, enjoy a meal at Entoto Park, with stunning views and a tranquil atmosphere. After lunch, you will continue to visit **Addis Ababa**. Then, head to the **New National Park**, which we call **Unity Park**, the palace of Ethiopia's former political leaders, including Haylesilase. Dinner. Overnight at the **JANO Hotel** or similar.





Day 2: From Addis-Abeba to Bahir Dar

Breakfast. Fly to Bahir Dar, a city on the shores of Lake Tana. Upon arrival, take a boat trip to visit island monasteries such as Kebran Gabriel, Ura Kidane Mehret, and Debre Maryam. Look out for hippos and local bird species during the trip. Lunch. Visit the Blue Nile Falls and the Portuguese Bridge, followed by a short boat trip.

Dinner. Overnight at the SKY Lake Side Resort or similar.

Day 3: From Bahir Dar to Gondar

Breakfast. Enjoy a scenic drive to Gondar, renowned for its fascinating medieval castles and historic architecture. Explore the Fasil Ghebbi royal complex, the Bath of Fasilides, and Birhan Selassie Debre Church, famous for its exceptional murals. Enjoy lunch at your hotel with stunning views. Dinner at the hotel. Overnight at the Goha Hotel or similar, for a comfortable night in the heart of this historic city.



Day 4: Excursion to the Simien Mountains

Breakfast. Drive to the Simien Mountains National Park, a spectacular UNESCO World Heritage Site renowned for its awe-inspiring landscapes. Enjoy a hike through this unique mountain range, offering breathtaking views of its rugged plateaus. You will have the opportunity to observe exceptional endemic wildlife, including Gelada baboons, Walia ibex, and rare Ethiopian wolves. This park is also a haven for nature and photography enthusiasts, offering an incomparable setting to immortalize every moment. **Lunch**. In the afternoon, enjoy panoramic views before returning to Gondar. **Dinner**. Overnight at the Goha Hotel or similar.









Day 5: From Gondar to Lalibela

After **breakfast**, fly to Lalibela and visit the first group of churches and witness the vibrant Meskel Festival. Lalibela, located in the Ethiopian highlands, is famous for its 11 monolithic churches carved directly into the red volcanic rock. These buildings, built in the 12th century during the reign of King Lalibela, are a masterpiece of religious architecture and a testament to the ingenuity of the craftsmen of the time. Each church is unique, with incredibly precise carved details, and they are still used as places of worship today. This sacred site is a UNESCO World Heritage Site, attracting pilgrims and visitors from around the world. **Lunch, dinner**. Overnight at Sora Lodge Lalibela or similar.



Day 6 : Lalibela Exploration

Breakfast.

Attend the vibrant Meskel (Demera) bonfire celebration, an Ethiopian festival marking the finding of the True Cross according to Orthodox Christian tradition. Witness this unique moment as pyres light up the sky, accompanied by songs and prayers. Afterward, explore the majestic remaining rock-hewn churches of Lalibela, architectural and spiritual masterpieces, each site offering invaluable insight into Ethiopian history and faith. A deeply immersive and enriching experience.

In the afternoon, enjoy a culinary immersion to discover Ethiopian specialties and enjoy a coffee ceremony, a true cultural and social tradition.

Lunch, dinner. Overnight at Sora Lodge Lalibela or similar.







Day 7 : From Lalibela to Addis-Abeba

Breakfast. Visit the iconic Bete Giyorgis (Church of St. George), then return to Addis Ababa. In the afternoon, free time. Dinner. Overnight at the JANO Hotel or similar.



Day 8: Towards southern Ethiopia

After **breakfast**, we head to the **village of Turmi** for an authentic immersion with the local population.

After lunch, we continue to discover other tribes. The **Hamer or Hamar tribe** has a famous ceremony, which we call "bull jumping." This ceremony is prepared or hosted by a young man about to get married. This ceremony is not performed every day; if necessary, we may attend. Otherwise, we will freely visit the **Hamer tribes** in their villages and return to our lodge for dinner. Overnight at Emerald Lodge or similar.







Day 9 : From Turmi Village to Jinka

Breakfast. Meet the Karo tribe, settled along the Omo River, famous for their unique art of body painting. Using natural pigments, the Karo adorn their skin with elaborate designs for ceremonies, symbolizing beauty and social status. These ephemeral works of art reflect their deep connection to nature and their ancestral traditions. The opportunity to interact with these people will immerse you in a rich and vibrant culture, where every gesture and pattern tells a unique story. An unforgettable experience in the heart of authentic Ethiopia. Lunch. Dinner. Overnight at Jinka Resort or similar.







Day 10: Fly back to Addis Ababa

Breakfast. We'll take a return flight to **Addis Ababa**. We'll begin packing your luggage to take you to the airport for your departure.

We'll arrive in **Addis Ababa** in the late afternoon and, if we have time, we'll do some last-minute souvenir shopping before departing.
