
THE PROGRAM

This South Africa tour offers cultural immersion upon arrival at Johannesburg OR Tambo airport. A visit to Constitution Hill, a former prison that chronicles the living conditions of prisoners during apartheid, is a great way to start the immersion. The trip continues with an exploration of Johannesburg's fashion district, accompanied by an atypical designer, to select a unique

African fabric and create a personalized jacket. The discovery of Soweto, dinner and an evening with Welile and his wife, as well as a visit to the association supported by the agency, are also on the program. The trip continues with an immersion in an authentic and lively Ndebele village, followed by a day in the wilderness to discover the natural wonders of the famous Panoramic Route. The tour includes all meals (except drinks) and transfers from the airport and back.

Day 1: your arrival in South Africa

Arrival at **Johannesburg** OR **Tambo** International Airport (depending on flight schedule). After collecting your luggage, welcome by our local representative. Assistance and transfer to your hotel and installation. Lunch at your leisure. Depending on your arrival time, you can start your trip with a cultural immersion in the heart of **Johannesburg**. Visit **Constitution Hill**, a former prison that recalls the living conditions of former prisoners during the apartheid era. This nontouristy site is a great way to dive into past history and start your South African immersion. Return transfer. Dinner included. Overnight at **Hallmark House Hotel** or similar.





Day 2: Discovering South African art

Explore and discover **Johannesburg's** fashion district like never before. The fashion capital and historic fashion plaza is located in **Johannesburg's Old Town**. Our famous, one-of-a-kind designer will accompany you to downtown fabric stores, where you will select a unique African print you love from hundreds of options.

You will then meet with a member of his design team and have your measurements taken. You'll work with them to create your custom jacket. Enjoy a new experience in the artistic neighborhoods of **Johannesburg**. Lunch included. In the afternoon, enjoy a discovery of one or more markets. Through its local colors and traditional dishes or spices, you will succumb to the local delicacies. Dinner included. Overnight at **Hallmark House Hotel** or similar.



Day 3: Soweto

After breakfast, transfer to your historical immersion in the township of Soweto. You will meet our local NK guide and much more. Head to one of Johannesburg's most famous suburbs. On your guided tuktuk tour, wander the streets of this tumultuous suburb. You'll discover one of the world's most famous streets: Vilakazi Street. known for being home to two Nobel Peace Prize winners, Nelson Mandela and Archbishop **Desmond Tutu.**

Enjoy the warmth of South Africans and feel the vibes of this historic neighborhood. Local lunch included. To continue your immersion, you will meet the association we support, The Shalk, and share unique moments with the members of the association and the children. To finish your day, meet Welile and his wife for dinner, but also to enjoy a safe evening in Return transfer. Soweto. Overnight at the Conference Centre Hotel or similar.



Day 4: Local immersion among the Ndebele



After breakfast, head north where you will have the opportunity to immerse yourself and experience life from a unique perspective. The authentic and lively **Ndebele village** serves the rural community and neighboring traditional villages. The villagers still live in a traditional way and practice their age-old customs, despite the influence of modernization. The houses and enclosures are painted with the colorful geometric patterns for which the **Ndebele** are famous, often incorporating modern aspects such as telephones and the South African flag. All meals are included (breakfast, lunch, local dinner) except drinks. Overnight in the village.




Day 5: Local authenticity

After breakfast, discover the solidarity trip that awaits you on site. Enjoy this unique day surrounded by the villagers and their families. Depending on the day's program, let yourself be guided by the local festivities or the discovery of the local customs and traditions of the Ndebele community. Discover the joy of living and the authenticity that reigns in this village. Lunch, dinner and overnight stay on site, all included except drinks.




Day 6: The Panoramic Drive and the Blyde River Canyon



After breakfast at dawn, make the most of this day in the middle of nature. It's time to say goodbye to your hosts. Drive along the road and explore the different views that South Africa has to offer. You will be able to see the Blyde River Canyon from all angles. Stop at the impressive waterfalls such as Lone Creek, Bridal Veil, Mac Mac pools and falls which will put you in the best conditions to start a short family hike. Picnic lunch included along the way. Take your time to admire the natural wonders around you and discover the local artisan markets. Take in the highlights of the famous Panoramic Route such as God's Window. Wonder View and The Pinnacle Rock which offer spectacular views of the area. Dinner included. Overnight at the Zur Alten Mine guesthouse or similar.

Day 7: "Hakuna Matata" in the Kruger Park!

After breakfast, enjoy your last moments around the **Blyde River Canyon** before continuing on to another adventure. Lunch included. En route to the **Kruger National Park**. It is one of the most famous parks in the world and is half the size of the Netherlands. Depart for a late day game drive. Be prepared to see the remarkable Big Five: buffalo, elephant, leopard, lion and rhino, as well as other impressive and remarkable wildlife: giraffe, crocodile, hippo, warthog, zebra. Dinner and overnight stay in an eco lodge or similar.











Day 8: Heading towards the south

After breakfast, rise at dawn to enjoy a final game drive before heading to **Johannesburg**. Lunch along the way. Flight to **Cape Town**. Arrival in **Cape Town**, visit the famous "**Victoria & Albert Waterfront**", a lively harbor area with shops and restaurants. Dinner included and overnight at the **Atlantic Beach Villa** guesthouse or similar.

Day 9: The Table Mountain

After breakfast, take a ride on the cable car to the most famous mountain, **Table Mountain**, and climb to the top of one of the seven wonders of nature. From here you can enjoy a breathtaking view of the entire city of **Cape Town**, weather permitting. If you want to enjoy even more the magic of being alone in front of this impressive nature, don't hesitate to take a few hours hike through **Lion's Head** or **Signal Hill**. Lunch is included.





Afternoon at leisure to allow you to rest. For the more adventurous, it is possible to continue your journey to the Kirstenbosch Botanical Gardens, which are located in the chic suburbs of Cape Town. The gardens showcase a wide variety of plants from Southern Africa. Part of the Kirstenbosch Gardens is located on the side of Table Mountain, and other species are grown in greenhouses at the Conservatory. Dinner is included. Overnight at the Atlantic Beach Villa guesthouse or similar.



Day 10: Cape Peninsula of Good Esperance

After breakfast, depart for **Simon's Town** to observe a colony of penguins that have chosen **Boulder's Beach** as their habitat. You are in one of the most southerly destinations in the world, so take the opportunity to see some of the highlights of the **Cape Peninsula**.

En route to Cape **Point** Lighthouse. where breathtaking view of False Bay and the open ocean awaits you. If you wish to rest a little, don't hesitate to take the funicular. Lunch is included. Descend to the Cape of Good Hope where an exceptional flora awaits you, offering a true sanctuary to the fynbos, the main vegetal system of the Cape Floral Kingdom. Return to the city. Dinner is included with a little surprise: you will be invited to participate in cooking workshop with a local Malay Overnight woman. Atlantic **Beach** Villa guesthouse or similar.





Day 11: Departure

After breakfast, depending on your flight time back home, it is possible to plan another optional activity. Otherwise, simply take advantage of these last moments to stroll along the harbor or do some souvenir shopping before your departure. Transfer back to **Cape Town** airport to catch your international flight. Lunch and dinner are on your own.
